PURSUANT to the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Kiwifruit Marketing Licensing Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Kiwifruit Marketing Licensing Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 31st day of March 1983.

2. Renewal of exporter's licence—Every exporter's licence that would, except for this regulation, expire on the 31st day of March 1983 pursuant to regulation 24 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 10 (a) of the Kiwifruit Marketing Licensing Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1) is hereby extended until the 31st day of March 1984.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the duration of kiwifruit exporter's licence that would otherwise expire on 31 March 1983 until 31 March 1984.
