PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Kindergarten Regulations 1959, Amendment No 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Kindergarten Regulations 1959\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) She shall be not less than 17 years of age on the last day of February in the year in which she commences her course of training, or in the case of a candidate possessing an educational qualification accepted by the Director as being higher than the minimum qualification required for the time being under paragraph (b) of this regulation, not less than 16 years 9 months of age at that date:”

(2) Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words “in any special case”, and substituting the words “from time to time”.
