THE KINDERGARTEN REGULATIONS 1959, AMENDMENT NO. 6

Pursuant to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Kindergarten Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Kindergarten Regulations 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of "Salary order", and substituting the following definition:
 - "'Salary order' means a determination by the Director-General of Education under the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969 in relation to the remuneration of members of the Education service:".
- 3. Recognition of kindergartens—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (3) the figure "60", and substituting the figure "50".
- 4. Grading and staffing—(1) The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking regulation 5, and substituting the following regulation—
- "5. (1) Each kindergarten shall be designated Grade O, Grade I, or Grade II, according to the number of children enrolled and such other considerations as the Minister may from time to time determine.

"Provided that the Director-General of Education may on grounds of special circumstances approve in respect of any kindergarten the appointment of an additional teacher."

- (2) Subclause (1) of regulation 2 of the Kindergarten Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 4 is hereby consequentially revoked.
- 5. Employment of untrained teachers—Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "Every teacher employed in a kindergarten", and substituting the words "Every person employed as a teacher in a kindergarten, other than an untrained assistant employed in a Grade O kindergarten in accordance with subclause (2) of regulation 5 of these regulations,".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Kindergarten Regulations 1959, and institute a new grade, Grade O, of kindergartens.
