Pursuant to the Local Authorities (Members' Contracts) Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Members' Contracts) Order (No. 2) 1956.
- 2. The First Schedule to the Local Authorities (Members' Contracts) Act 1954, as amended by the Local Authorities (Members' Contracts) Order 1956,* is hereby further amended by inserting in Part II, after the reference to the Timaru High School Board, the following words:

"The Tourist Hotel Corporation | 1955, No. 89 of New Zealand The Touris

1955, No. 89— The Tourist Hotel Corporation
