THE LICENSING ACT EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939.

GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 4th day of October, 1939.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Licensing Act Emergency Regulations 1939.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Licensing Act, 1908, where the holder of a license under that Act has, whether before or after the commencement of these regulations, been called up for naval, military, or air service within New Zealand, or elsewhere, a transfer of the license may be granted to the wife of the licensee:

Provided that the Licensing Committee may require the license to be transferred back to the former holder of the license on his discharge from such service.
