



**THE LICENSING ACT EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942
(NO. 2), AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 28th day of
April, 1943.

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Licensing Act Emergency Regulations 1942 (No. 2), Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Licensing Act Emergency Regulations 1942 (No. 2),* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 15 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "that the failure to maintain the premises at the required standard", and substituting the words "that from any cause whatsoever, whether due to war conditions or not, the premises are not of the required standard or do not contain the required accommodation and that the failure to maintain the premises at the required standard, or to restore them to that standard,".

3. The principal regulations are hereby further amended by adding thereto the following new regulation :—

"25. (1) Nothing in subsection (2) of section 43 of the Licensing Act, 1908 (relating to the qualifications of members of Licensing Committees), shall apply or be deemed heretofore to have applied to disqualify a person who is appointed, whether before or after the commencement of this regulation, to any office the creation of which arises out of the prosecution of the present war.

"(2) If any question arises as to whether any person has been appointed to an office the creation of which has arisen out of the prosecution of the present war it shall be determined by the Minister of Justice, and his decision shall be final."
