REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Licensing Act Emergency Regulations 1942 (No. 2), Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Licensing Act Emergency Regulations 1942 (No. 2)* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
