HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Authorities (Temporary Housing) Emergency Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Authorities (Temporary Housing) Emergency Regulations 1944* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of the term "local authority", the following definition:—
 - "'Society' means a society incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act, 1908:".
- 3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "local authority" wherever they occur, the words "or society".
- 4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—
- "4. Any local authority may take under the Public Works Act, 1928, any land for the purpose of a transit housing centre, and any local authority or society may purchase, take on lease, or otherwise acquire, or arrange for the use of any land for the purpose of a transit housing centre."
- 5. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "local authority" wherever they occur, the words "or society".
- 6. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the words "or established in the district of the local authority by any society".

- 7. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "local authority," the words "or society".
- 8. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding the following regulation:—
- "10. Where any society establishes a transit housing centre under these regulations it shall, unless the Minister of Finance in any case otherwise directs, operate the centre subject to the general control and directions of the local authority in whose district the centre is situated."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

The purpose of these regulations is to confer on incorporated societies the power to establish and control transit housing centres, subject, unless the Minister of Finance in any case otherwise directs, to the general supervision of the local authority in whose district the centre is situated.
