ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 19 (1A) of the Legal Aid Act 1969 (as inserted by section 8 (2) of the Legal Aid Amendment Act 1974), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Legal Aid (Disposable Income) Order 1977.

2. Amounts to be deducted in determining disposable income—The Schedule to the Legal Aid Act 1969 (as added by section 8 (5) of the Legal Aid Amendment Act 1974 and amended by the Legal Aid (Disposable Income) Order (No. 2) 1975) is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from clause (1) the expression “\$2,483”, and substituting the expression “\$3,031”:
- (b) By omitting from clause (2) the expression “\$1,066”, and substituting the expression “\$1,432”:
- (c) By omitting from clause (3) (a) (i) the expression “\$1,118”, and substituting the expression “\$1,484”.

3. Revocation—The Legal Aid (Disposable Income) Order (No. 2) 1975* is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases some of the amounts to be deducted from the income of an applicant for legal aid in determining the applicant's disposable income for the purposes of the Legal Aid Act 1969.
