PURSUANT to section 2 (3) of the Local Authorities (Members' Interests) Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Members' Interests) Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on 17 July 1997.

2. First Schedule of Local Authorities (Members' Interests) Act 1968 amended—Part II of the First Schedule of the Local Authorities (Members' Interests) Act 1968 is amended by inserting, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the following item:

“Chatham Islands Council | 1995, No. 41—The Chatham Islands
Council Act 1995.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 17 July 1997, inserts into Part II of the First Schedule of the Local Authorities (Members' Interests) Act 1968 a reference to the Chatham Islands Council. That part of that schedule specifies the particular local authorities and public bodies to which that Act applies. The Chatham Islands Council was constituted by the Chatham Islands Council Act 1995 in place of the former Chatham Islands County Council.
