O R D E R

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Employment Protection) Order 1971.

2. Local authorities—The First Schedule to the Local Authorities (Employment Protection) Act 1963 is hereby amended by inserting in the appropriate columns of Part I, before the item relating to Borough Councils, the following item:
