### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of June 1979

Pursuant to section 2 (2) of the Local Authorities (Employment Protection) Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Employment Protection) Order 1979.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Regional Planning Authorities—Part I of the First Schedule to the Local Authorities (Employment Protection) Act 1963 is hereby amended by inserting in its appropriate alphabetical order the following item:

"Regional Planning Authorities

...... 1977, No. 121—The Town and Country Planning Act 1977."

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides for employees of Regional Planning Authorities to come within the ambit of the Local Authorities (Employment Protection) Act 1963.
