

## THE LEASED CIRCUITS AND LEASED APPARATUS REGULATIONS 1976, AMENDMENT NO. 1

#### Present.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Leased Circuits and Leased Apparatus Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Leased Circuits and Leased Apparatus Regulations 1976\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Removals—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 9, the following regulation:
- "9A. Subject to the approval of the Department, subscribers may have their leased circuits removed to other premises or the position of the leased circuits altered, upon giving sufficient notice in writing and paying the fees prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations."
- 3. Part-time lease—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by inserting, after regulation 10, the following regulation:
- "10A. Where the lease of a circuit is desired for part-time use only, the lease may be granted conditionally on the availability of appropriate circuits and on the applicant agreeing in writing to pay the hourly charges

as prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations in respect to circuits, with a minimum charge as for 1 hour, together with the installation fees prescribed."

**4. Charge for leased circuits**—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the new Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

## SCHEDULE NEW SCHEDULE TO PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

CHARGES FOR LEASED CIRCUITS

#### Part I

#### Normal Lease

1. Charges for leased circuits shall consist of Local Circuit charges,

and, in some cases, Main Line Circuit charges.

The designation of circuits or parts of circuits as main line circuits or as local circuits shall be as decided by the Director-General from time to time.

#### Local Circuits

2. The rate for local circuits shall be \$7 per kilometre, or part kilometre, each 2 months, for circuits designated as \$1, \$T1, \$T2, \$T3, \$T4. For circuit categories \$2, \$S3, \$P1, \$P2 the rate shall be \$11 per kilometre, or part kilometre, each 2 months. For local circuit parts of other circuits the rate shall be as decided by the Director-General from time to time.

#### Main Line Circuits

3. Main line circuits shall be of types designated as S1, S2, S3, T1, T2, T3, T4, P1, P2, B1, and B2. The specifications for each type of circuit shall be as decided by the Director-General from time to time.

The rates for main line circuits shall be as in Appendix A.

#### Part II

#### Temporary lease

#### Local Circuits

1. The rate for the temporary lease of local circuits S1, T1, T2, T3, T4 shall be \$1.21 per kilometre per week, for a minimum period of 2 weeks, and \$1.90 per kilometre per week for circuits S2, S3, P1, P2, for a minimum period of 2 weeks. For temporary lease of the local circuit parts of other circuits the rates shall be as decided by the Director-General from time to time.

#### Main Line Circuits

2. The rates for the temporary lease of main line circuits shall be as in Appendix B.

### **Installation and Reconnection Charges**

#### Installation Charges

1. Installation charges shall be \$50 for each end of a circuit designated S1, T1, T2, T3, and \$70 for each end of a circuit designated S2, P1, P2. For other circuits installation charges shall be based on the cost of labour and incidental expenses involved in their provision.

#### Reconnection Charges

2. The reconnection fee shall be \$15.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for removals and part-time leases of circuits and increase the fees payable under the Leased Circuits and Leased Apparatus Regulations 1976 with effect from 1 October 1977.
