PURSUANT to section 31 of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Licensing Districts Order 1970.
- 2. Licensing districts—The second column of the First Schedule to the Sale of Liquor Act 1962 is hereby amended—
  - (a) By omitting from the description of the Auckland Licensing District the word "Manukau", and substituting the word "Waiheke"; and by omitting from that description the words "Waiheke Road District and":
  - (b) By omitting from the description of the East Coast Licensing District the word "Matakaoa", and also the word "Uawa":
  - (c) By omitting from the description of the Wanganui Licensing District the words "and also Mangaweka Town District":(d) By omitting from the description of the Marlborough Licensing
  - Obstrict the word "Sounds", and also the words "and also the Kenepuru and Croisilles French Pass Road Districts":
  - (e) By omitting from the description of the Nelson Licensing District the word "Murchison":
  - (f) By omitting from the description of the Hurunui Licensing District the word "Kowai":
  - (g) By omitting from the description of the Canterbury Licensing District the word "Selwyn", and also the words "Springs", "Tawera", and "Halswell":
  - "Tawera", and "Halswell":

    (h) By omitting from the description of the Dunedin Licensing District the word "Peninsula".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order amends the descriptions of certain licensing districts in the First Schedule to the Sale of Liquor Act 1962 by omitting references to counties and other local body districts that have been abolished since the Act was passed.
