## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of June 1971

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Local Elections and Polls Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and at the request of the local authorities to which this order applies, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Local Elections and Polls (Postal Voting) Order 1971.
- 2. Local Authorities authorised to conduct elections by postal vote— The Returning Officers at the triennial general elections of members (including, in the case of boroughs, the triennial general elections of Mayors) of the local authorities specified in the Schedule to this order to be held on the 9th day of October 1971 are hereby authorised to conduct those elections by postal vote only.
