PURSUANT to section 64B (2) of the Local Elections and Polls Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Local Government given at the request of the Porirua City Council, hereby makes the following order.

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Local Elections and Polls (Postal Voting) Order 1975.
- 2. Porirua City Council authorised to conduct poll by postal vote— The Returning Officer at the Pukerua Bay Water and Sewerage Reticulation Loan Poll to be held in the City of Porirua on the 22nd day of March 1975 is hereby authorised to conduct that poll by postal vote.
