2. Commencement of Local Government Amendment Act (No. 5) 1996—The Local Government Amendment Act (No. 5) 1996 comes into force on 1 July 2000.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, on 1 July 2000, the Local Government Amendment Act (No. 5) 1996.

The Act repeals section 594B (1)(b)(i) of the Local Government Act 1974, which excludes from the definition of “local authority trading enterprise” in that section any airport company within the meaning of the Airport Authorities Act 1966.
