PURSUANT to section 223 of the Local Government Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Local Government (Territorial Authorities) Accounting Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Government (Territorial Authorities) Accounting Regulations 1979* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- **2. Revocation**—Regulation 10 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the proviso.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations revoke a provision empowering the Secretary for Local Government to extend the time within which a territorial authority must prepare an annual financial statement under the Local Government (Territorial Authorities) Accounting Regulations 1979.
