



**THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (REGIONAL AND TERRITORIAL
AUTHORITIES ANNUAL ALLOWANCES AND REMUNERATION)
DETERMINATION 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 214B of the Local Government Act 1974, the Minister of Local Government (having due regard to the changes in certain annual allowances determined by the Higher Salaries Commission in a determination dated the 19th day of March 1986 and made under section 214A of the Local Government Act 1974 and such other matters as the Minister considers relevant), hereby makes the following determination.

DETERMINATION

1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Local Government (Regional and Territorial Authorities Annual Allowances and Remuneration) Determination 1986, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Government (Regional and Territorial Authorities Annual Allowances and Remuneration) Determination 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal determination).

(2) This determination shall take effect on and from the 1st day of April 1985 (being the date on and from which the determination of the Higher Salaries Commission dated the 19th day of March 1986 takes effect).

2. Remuneration of members—Clause 7 of the principal determination is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3), and substituting the following subclause:

“(3) Nothing in subclause (2) of this clause shall apply in respect of any day on which the member,—

“(a) Attends a meeting of any committee of the council constituted to hear applications and objections made under the Town and Country Planning Act 1977 or to consider submissions made under that Act; and

“(b) Does not attend any other meeting of the council or of any committee of the council.”

3. Amendments to First Schedule—(1) The First Schedule to the principal determination is hereby amended by adding to item 6 in Part I the words “so long as the population of the city, county, or district exceeds 20 000 and does not exceed 50 000”.

(2) The First Schedule to the principal determination is hereby amended by omitting from item 2 in Table A of Part II the words “but not exceeding 100 000”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

Clause 2: The effect of the change made by this clause is that if a member attends a town planning committee meeting but no other council or committee meeting on the same day, that day is not to be counted towards the maximum of 104 days in respect of which the member may receive remuneration.

Clause 3 provides that the rates for Mayors and Chairmen of certain authorities named in the principal determination are only to apply while the population of the district of the authority is between 20 000 and 50 000. The clause also omits words that limits one category of regional and united councils to a maximum population of 100 000. This category will now include all such councils with a population of more than 50 000.
