THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1950

PURSUANT to the Local Government Commission Act, 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Government

Commission (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1950.

2. (1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949* shall apply to and shall be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Local Government Commission established under the Local Government Commission Act, 1946, and the members of the Commission (other than the Chairman).

(2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s.

o dow .

Provided that where a member is entitled to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional

amount of 2s. may be paid to that member.

(3) The mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table:—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.
Not exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$ Exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$ but not exceeding $14\frac{1}{2}$ Over $14\frac{1}{4}$	 $5\frac{1}{2}$ d. a mile. $6\frac{1}{4}$ d. a mile. 7d. a mile.

(4) Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred.

3. The Local Government Commission (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1947† are hereby revoked.
