

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (ELECTRIC POWER BOARDS SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES) DETERMINATION 1990

PURSUANT to section 101zzr of the Local Government Act 1974 (as inserted by section 15 (1) of the Local Government Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989), the Minister of Local Government, acting with the consent of the Minister of Energy, hereby makes the following determination.

DETERMINATION

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Local Government (Electric Power Boards Salaries and Allowances) Determination 1990.
- (2) This determination shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from the 1st day of November 1989.
- 2. Interpretation—(1) In this determination, unless the context otherwise requires,—
 - "Act" means the Local Government Act 1974:
 - "Board"—
 - (a) Means an Electric Power Board within the meaning of the Electric Power Boards Act 1925; and
 - (b) Includes—
 - (i) The Auckland Electric Power Board; and
 - (ii) The Rotorua Area Electricity Authority; and
 - (iii) The Waikato Electricity Authority; and
 - (iv) The Hutt Valley Energy Board.

- (2) Unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in this determination have the same meaning as in the Act.
- **3. Maximum salaries of Chairpersons**—The maximum salary payable pursuant to Part IVc of the Act to the Chairperson of a board shall be the maximum salary applicable under Part I of the Schedule to this determination.
- 4. Maximum salaries of Deputy Chairpersons and Chairpersons of committees of boards—The maximum salary payable pursuant to Part IVc of the Act to—
 - (a) The Deputy Chairperson of a board; or
- (b) The Chairperson of one or more committees of a board,— shall be the maximum salary applicable under Part II of the Schedule to this determination.
- **5. Maximum salaries of members of boards**—The maximum salary payable pursuant to Part IVc of the Act to a member of a board shall be the maximum salary applicable under Part III of the Schedule to this determination.
- **6. One salary only payable**—The payment by a board of the salaries referred to in section 101zz of the Act is subject to the condition that the board shall not pay to a person more than one of those salaries.
- 7. Maximum meeting allowances to members of boards—The maximum meeting allowance payable pursuant to Part IVc of the Act to each member of a board (other than its Chairperson) shall be the maximum meeting allowance applicable under Part IV of the Schedule to this determination.
- 8. Conditions in relation to payment of meeting allowances to members of board—The payment of a meeting allowance to a member of a board (other than its Chairperson) is subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) The board shall pay a meeting allowance to a member of the board only in respect of a day on which the member of the board attends—
 - (i) A meeting of the board; or
 - (ii) A meeting of a committee of the board where the member of the board is a member of the committee or is required to attend the meeting in his or her capacity as a member of the board:
 - (b) The board shall pay only one meeting allowance under clause 7 of this determination to a person in respect of any one day, notwithstanding that that person attends more than one meeting (being a meeting of the board or of a committee of the board) on that day:
 - (c) A meeting that continues past midnight otherwise than by adjournment shall be regarded as having concluded before midnight.
- **9. Minimum salaries and minimum meeting allowances**—(1) The minimum salary payable pursuant to Part IVc of the Act in respect of each

of the positions referred to in clauses 3, 4, and 5 of this determination shall be in each case an annual salary equal to 10 percent of the maximum annual salary applicable.

(2) The minimum meeting allowance payable pursuant to Part IVc of the Act to each member of a board (other than its Chairperson) shall be a meeting allowance equal to 10 percent of the maximum meeting allowance

applicable.

10. Revocation—The Local Government (Electric Power Boards Annual Allowances and Remuneration) Determination 1989* is hereby revoked.

Local Government (Electric Power Boards Salaries and Allowances) Determination 1990

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination, which is deemed to have taken effect on and from 1 November 1989,-

(a) Fixes the maximum and minimum annual salaries that may be paid to-

- (i) A chairperson of an electric power board: (ii) A deputy chairperson of an electric power board:
- (iii) A chairperson of a committee of an electric power board:

(iv) Any member of an electric power board:

(b) Fixes the maximum and minimum meeting allowances payable to each member (other than the Chairperson) of an electric power board.

The rates of remuneration are increased in each case. The previous determination took effect on and from 1 April 1988.
