PURSUANT to the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Licensed Industries General Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Licensed Industries General Regulations 1940* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. The principal regulations are amended by deleting the words "Department of Industries and Commerce, Tourist and Publicity" wherever they appear, and substituting therefor the words "Department of Industries and Commerce".
- **4.** Clauses 6:4, 6:5, and 7:8 of the principal regulations are amended by deleting the word "Minister" wherever it appears in the said clauses, and substituting therefor the words "Industrial Efficiency Appeal Authority".
- 5. Forms Nos. 1 and 3 in the Schedule to the principal regulations are amended by deleting the word "Minister" wherever it appears, and substituting therefor the words "Industrial Efficiency Appeal Authority".
