Pursuant to section 46 of the Licensing Trusts Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Local Licensing Trusts Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Licensing Trusts Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date

of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Provisions of Licensing Trusts Act 1949 not applicable to local Trusts—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the figures "34a", the figures "34B".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The Schedule to the Local Licensing Trusts Regulations 1966 lists those sections of the Licensing Trusts Act 1949 that do not apply to local Trusts.

The amendment made by these regulations includes section 34B in that list. Section 34B (which is applicable to district licensing Trusts) was enacted by the Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1967, and authorises Trusts to vary by resolution the normal hours fixed for the sale of liquor in their hotel and tavern premises. It cannot apply to local Trusts, which hold licences under the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, and which will have the right to apply to a Licensing Committee under section 221A of that Act (as enacted by section 3 of the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act (No. 2) 1967) for such a variation.
