PURSUANT to section 2 of the Litter Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. **Title**—This order may be cited as the Litter Order 1969.

2. **Declaring body to be a public authority for the purposes of the Litter Act 1968**—The **Dunedin Ocean Beach Domain Board** constituted under the Ocean Beach Public Domain Act 1892 is hereby declared to be a public authority for the purposes of the Litter Act 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to declare the **Dunedin Ocean Beach Domain Board** a public authority within the meaning of section 2 of the Litter Act 1968. It will enable the board to exercise all the powers and duties conferred on public authorities by that Act.
