**THE LAW PRACTITIONERS ACT (DISCIPLINARY) RULES 1936,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Law Practitioners Amendment Act, 1935, the Disciplinary Committee of the New Zealand Law Society doth hereby make the following rule :—

1. This rule may be cited as the Law Practitioners Act (Disciplinary) Rules 1936, Amendment No. 1.

2. This rule shall be read together with and form part of the Law Practitioners Act (Disciplinary) Rules 1936\* (hereinafter called the principal rules).

3. Clause 9 of the principal rules shall be called 9 (a).

4. The following subclause 9 (b) shall be added :—

“ The Committee shall have power at their own discretion, or upon the application of a practitioner as to whom they have made an order, to suspend the operation of such order, and/or to suspend the sending of the said findings and order to the said Registrar, pending the hearing and determination of an appeal under section 16 of the Law Practitioners Amendment Act, 1935.”

The foregoing amendment was duly made by the Disciplinary Committee of the New Zealand Law Society at a meeting of the said Committee held at Wellington on the 18th day of August, 1938.
