# GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 5th day of November, 1940.

### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Law Practitioners Emergency Regulations 1940.
- 2. Any District Law Society may in its discretion, either unconditionally or upon or subject to such conditions as it thinks fit, refund to any barrister or solicitor who for the time being is or has been serving continuously as a member of any of His Majesty's Naval, Military, or Air Forces the whole or any part of any fee paid to the Society in respect of an annual certificate under Part I of the Law Practitioners Act, 1931.
- 3. Where pursuant to the last preceding clause the District Law Society refunds the whole of any fee to which subsection (2) of section 45 of the Law Practitioners Act, 1931, applies no amounts shall be payable in respect of that fee to the New Zealand Law Society or the New Zealand Council of Law Reporting under paragraph (b) or paragraph (c) of that subsection. Where a proportion of any such fee is so refunded the amounts to which the District Law Society, the New Zealand Law Society, and the New Zealand Council of Law Reporting are respectively entitled under that subsection shall each be reduced by the same proportion.

4. The committee of management of the Solicitors' Fidelity Guarantee Fund may in its discretion, either unconditionally or upon or subject to such conditions as it thinks fit, remit or refund the whole or any part of any fee payable under section 80 of the Law Practitioners Act, 1931, by any solicitor who for the time being is or has been serving continuously as a member of any of His Majesty's Naval, Military, or Air Forces.
