



**THE LIGHTING RESTRICTIONS EMERGENCY REGULATIONS
1941, AMENDMENT NO. 4**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day of
May, 1943

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Lighting Restrictions Emergency Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Lighting Restrictions Emergency Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

3. Part II of the principal regulations, as set out in Regulation 7 of the Lighting Restrictions Emergency Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, is hereby amended by adding, after Regulation 12, the following new regulation :—

“ REGULATION 12A.—LIGHTING RESTRICTIONS TRIALS

“(1) The Chairman of the central committee of the emergency precautions service established in any district under the Emergency Reserve Corps Regulations 1941† may from time to time declare by public notice that any period specified in the notice shall, for the purposes of these regulations, be deemed to be a period of emergency in respect of the district or any specified locality or localities within the district, and the provisions of Regulation 12 hereof shall apply accordingly during every period specified in any such notice.”
