THE LAKE ROTOPOUNAMU FAUNISTIC RESERVE NOTICE 1966

Pursuant to regulation 64 of the Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1963*, the Minister of Marine hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Lake Rotopounamu Faunistic Reserve Notice 1966.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Lake Rotopounamu situated in the County of Taupo is hereby declared to be a faunistic reserve.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of the declaration of Lake Rotopounamu as a faunistic reserve is to make it unlawful, except with the consent of the Secretary for Marine given solely for the purposes of scientific investigation, to take from the Lake any fish, mollusca, crustacea, protozoa, insecta, or worms, or to be in the possession of any of the same taken from the Lake, or to introduce any form of aquatic plant into the Lake.
