**THE LAND SETTLEMENT PROMOTION AND LAND
ACQUISITION REGULATIONS 1968, AMENDMENT NO. 4**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of February 1975

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Land Settlement Promotion and Land Acquisition Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Land Settlement Promotion and Land Acquisition Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Land Settlement Promotion and Land Acquisition Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Transactions exempted—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Land Settlement Promotion and Land Acquisition Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 1, and by regulation 2 of the Land Settlement Promotion and Land Acquisition Regulations 1972, Amendment No. 2) is hereby further amended by adding the following subclause:

“(5) Nothing in Part II of the said Act shall apply with respect to any lease, or any contract or agreement for a lease, of farm land of an area of not more than 10 hectares granted by any Catchment Board or any Catchment Commission constituted under the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 or by the Waikato Valley Authority constituted under the Waikato Valley Authority Act 1956 or by the Wellington Regional Water Board constituted under the Wellington Regional Water Board Act 1972.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 exempts from the provisions of Part II of the Land Settlement Promotion and Land Acquisition Act 1952 leases comprising not more than 10 hectares of farm land granted by Catchment Boards or Catchment Commissions or by the Waikato Valley Authority or the Wellington Regional Water Board.
