PURSUANT to the Land Settlement Promotion Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Land Settlement Promotion Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Land Settlement Promotion Regulations 1959\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from regulation 2 the words “paragraphs (a), (b), and (c)”, and substituting the words “paragraphs (a) and (b)”:
- (b) By revoking clause 7 of form 1 in the Schedule thereto:
- (c) By revoking clause 6 of form 2 in the Schedule thereto.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations make such changes in the principal regulations as are necessary following the repeal by the Land Settlement Promotion Amendment Act 1961 of the provisions as to personal residence contained in the Land Settlement Promotion Act 1952.
