PURSUANT to the Legal Services Act 1991, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Services Regulations 1991, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Legal Services Regulations 1991* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1993.
- **2. New form 2 substituted**—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking form 2, and substituting the form 2 set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
