



LAKE TAUPO AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1997

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 23rd day of June 1997

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 6 and section 232 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Lake Taupo Amendment Regulations 1997, and are part of the Lake Taupo Regulations 1976* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. New Schedules substituted—The principal regulations are amended by revoking the Schedules (as substituted by the Lake Taupo Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 12), and substituting the Schedules set out in the Schedule of these regulations.

3. Revocations—The Lake Taupo Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 12, is consequentially revoked.

NEW SCHEDULES SUBSTITUTED IN PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS
"FIRST SCHEDULE
"ANNUAL FEES

1. Fees for mooring sites—Either \$120.00 or an amount calculated at a rate of \$9.50 per metre of the length of the craft to be moored at the site, calculated on the basis of the overall length of the craft including all permanent extrusions, whichever is the greater.

2. Fee for permit to use launching ramps and similar facilities controlled by Secretary—\$45.00 per craft.

3. Fees for berths and wharves, jetties, and breastworks—

1. Fees for permit to use launching ramps and similar facilities controlled by Secretary—

- (c) \$17.00 per craft for a permit valid for 1 month.

2. Fees for berths at wharves, jetties, and breastworks—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come in force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, prescribe new fees payable under the Lake Taupo Regulations 1976. Fees for permits to use launching ramps and fees for licences for rental vessels are reduced. All other fees are increased.
