PURSUANT to section 236 (1) (a) of the Land Transfer Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Land Transfer Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Land Transfer Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1984.

2. Fee for search copies of certificates of title under section 172A of the Act—The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Land Transfer Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by adding the following item:
