



## THE LAKE TAUPO REGULATIONS 1976, AMENDMENT NO. 1

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of November 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Lake Taupo Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Lake Taupo Regulations 1976\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Use of wharves and facilities**—Regulation 10 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “or erected”, and substituting the words “erected, or controlled”.

**3. First Schedule amended**—(1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking clause 3, and substituting the following clause:

“3. *Fees for licences for commercial vessels*—

<i>Length of vessel</i>	<i>Fee</i>
6 metres or less	\$100
more than 6 metres but not more than 9 metres	\$140
more than 9 metres but not more than 12 metres	\$180
more than 12 metres but not more than 15 metres	\$230
over 15 metres	\$300”

(2) The said First Schedule is hereby further amended by adding to clause 6 the following paragraph:

“(d) At Motuoapa marina—\$75.”

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations reduce the annual licence fees payable in respect of commercial vessels of 15 m or less operating on Lake Taupo, increase the fee by \$25 for vessels over 15 m, and prescribe a fee for the use of the Motuoapa marina.
