PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Lake Taupo Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Lake Taupo Regulations 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the Gazette, prescribe new fees payable under the Lake Taupo Regulation 1976. Ramp fees are reduced and most other fees are increased.
