At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 10th day of March 1952

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Milk Authorities Appeals Regulations 1952.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the fifth day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) The application referred to in subsection (2) of section 71 of the Milk Act 1944 shall be an originating application under the Magistrates' Courts Rules 1948,* and the provisions of those rules shall apply thereto.

(2) The appellant shall file with the originating application a copy of the decision which is being appealed against. No fee shall be payable for filing the copy of the decision.

(3) Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this regulation shall affect any proceedings by way of appeal that have been commenced in a Magistrate's Court before the commencement of these regulations, and of which notice has been given to the Milk Authority pursuant to the said section 71; and any such appeal as aforesaid may be continued and disposed of as if it had been commenced pursuant to these regulations.

(4) Except as provided in subclause (2) of this regulation, the fees to be taken in respect of proceedings under these regulations shall be those prescribed by the Magistrates' Courts Rules 1948.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
