PURSUANT to the Medical and Dental Auxiliaries Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Medical and Dental Auxiliaries Act Commencement Order 1968.
- 2. Commencement of Act in relation to occupation of dental technician—The Medical and Dental Auxiliaries Act 1966 shall come into force in relation to the registrable occupation of dental technician on the 1st day of April 1969.
