1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters (Section 24 (3)) Order 1999.

(2) This order comes into force on 1 March 1999.

Requests under Part III in accordance with United Nations Convention Against Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances—Requests for assistance under Part III of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992 made in accordance with the United Nations Convention Against Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs

and Pyschotropic Substances may be dealt with on or after 16 March 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 March 1999, is made under section 24 (3) of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992. It appoints 16 March 1999 as the date on or after which requests for assistance under Part III of the Act made in accordance with the United Nations Convention Against Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Pyschotropic Substances may be dealt with.
