PURSUANT to section 65 of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992, Her Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters (Prescribed Foreign Country) (Fiji) Regulations 1999.
 - (2) These regulations come into force on 13 September 1999.

2. Part III of Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992 to apply to Fiji—Part III of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992 applies to the Republic of the Fiji Islands.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 13 September 1999, provide that Part III of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992 applies to Fiji. This means that requests may be made by Fiji to New Zealand for assistance under that Part of that Act.
