THE MASTERS AND MATES EXAMINATION RULES 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 4

PURSUANT to the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, the Minister of Marine hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Masters and Mates Examination Rules 1940, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Masters and Mates Examination Rules, 1940* (hereinafter called the principal rules).
 - 2. These rules shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1948.
- 3. The principal rules are hereby amended by revoking subclause (c) of clause 2 of Rule 6:32 and clause (2) of Rule 17:01 and the number "(1)" next following the number "17:01" in that rule as added and inserted by Rules 5 and 6 respectively of the Masters and Mates Examination Rules 1940, Amendment No. 1†.
- 4. The principal rules are hereby amended by revoking Rule 2:09 and clauses (2), (3), and (4) of Rule 8:02 and the number "(1)" next following the number "8:02" in that rule as inserted and added by Rules 4 and 5 respectively of the Masters and Mates Examination Rules 1940, Amendment No. 2‡.
- 5. The Masters and Mates Examination Rules 1940, Amendment No. 2‡, are hereby revoked.
