At the Government House at Wellington, this 24th day of October, 1940.

PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Money-order Amending Regulations 1940.
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.
- 3. Regulation 3 of the Money-order Amending Regulations 1939* is hereby revoked.
- 4. The commission on money-orders issued in New Zealand payable in New Zealand or Cook Islands shall be 7d. for the first £10 and 3d. for each additional £5 or part of £5.
