ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of November, 1946

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Money-order Amending Regulations 1946.

2. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1946.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the regulations made under the Post and Telegraph Act, 1908, respectively, on the 18th day of August, 1913, and the 20th day of December, 1919, and enuring under the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, or in any other enactment, a single money-order may be issued in New Zealand or the Cook Islands for an amount exceeding £40, but no such money-order shall be issued for a greater amount than £100.
