THE MEAT ACT SUSPENSION EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

At the Government House at Wellington, this 18th day of February, 1942.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Meat Act Suspension Emergency Regulations 1942.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section 29, section 40, or section 55 of the Meat Act, 1939, every meat-export slaughterhouse license and rural slaughterhouse license and meat-exporter's license in force under that Act on the 30th day of June, 1942, or thereafter granted, shall, unless sooner cancelled, surrendered, or revoked in accordance with the provisions of that Act, continue in force until the 30th day of June next after the date on which these regulations cease to be in force.
