**THE MAORI BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION  
REGULATIONS 1935, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

FREYBERG, Governor-General  
ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 25th day of June 1952

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Maori Births and Deaths Registration Regulations 1935, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Maori Births and Deaths Registration Regulations 1935\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1952.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule thereto, and substituting the following Schedule:—

Search in any index or records in the office of the Registrar-General, in respect of each name or entry searched—

For every search extending beyond a period of ten years .....	10	0
For every search extending beyond a period of twenty years .....	15	0
For every certified copy of any entry in a register book kept in a Registrar's Office, and for every certified copy of any entry in the records in the office of the Registrar-General (including search not extending beyond three years) .....	5	0
For every certificate of the date of birth or death .....	2	0
Verification of date of birth or death or inspection of entry where no search fee is payable .....	2	0”
