



**THE MEAT BOARD ELECTION AMENDING
REGULATIONS 1944**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Meat-export Control Act, 1921-22, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Meat Board Election Amending Regulations 1944, and shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under the said Act on the 7th day of June, 1923 (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

2. These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day following the date of notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

3. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations, as replaced by the regulation made under the said Act on the 21st day of June, 1928, is hereby amended—

(a) By revoking clause (1) thereof, and substituting the following clause therefor :—

“(1) No member of the Board or the New Zealand Wool Council referred to in section 69 of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1939, and no person who has been nominated for appointment at the next ensuing election to either of the said bodies, shall be eligible for nomination as a delegate :

(b) By adding to clause (5) thereof the following words :—

“Provided that the last day for receiving nominations shall be at least one week later than the last day fixed under Regulation 10 hereof for receiving nominations for election as a producer’s representative”.
