

THE MEAT BOARD REGULATIONS 1970, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of August 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Meat Export Control Act 1921–22 and the Wool Industry Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat Board Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Board Regulations 1970* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of

August 1978.

2. Meetings—Regulation 10 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 6 of the Meat Board Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by revoking subclauses (2) and (3), and substituting the following subclauses:

"(2) The Chairman of the Meat Board and the Chairman of the Wool Board shall submit to the Electoral Committee meeting in March for its consideration the reports and balance sheets relating to their respective Board's operations during that Board's previous financial year.

"(3) The Chairman of the Electoral Committee shall preside at all meetings of the Electoral Committee except to the extent that, at the March meeting, the Chairman of the Meat Board or, as the case may require, the Chairman of the Wool Board shall preside as Chairman of the Electoral Committee at those times the reports and balance

sheets of their respective Boards are being presented and discussed."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Meat Board Regulations 1970 by changing, from August to March, the Electoral Committee meeting at which the Wool Board's annual report and balance sheet is to be presented and discussed.
