PURSUANT to section 301A (2) of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Municipal Corporations (Earthquake Dangers) Order 1976.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2. Section 301A of Act to apply to Papakura City Council and Ngarua-wahia Borough Council—(1) The Papakura City Council is hereby declared to be a Council to which section 301A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 applies.

(2) The Ngaruawahia Borough Council is hereby declared to be a Council to which section 301A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 applies.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order empowers the Councils named to exercise the powers conferred by section 301A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 in relation to buildings likely to be dangerous in an earthquake.
