ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of November 1978

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 301A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order:

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Municipal Corporations (Earthquake Dangers) Order 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Section 301A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 to apply to Petone Borough Council—The Petone Borough Council is hereby declared to be a council to which section 301A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 applies.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.
This order empowers Petone Borough Council to exercise the powers conferred by section 301A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 in relation to buildings likely to be dangerous in an earthquake.
