PURSUANT to the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, His Excellency the  
Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the  
Executive Council, and on the application to the Minister of Internal  
Affairs by the Councils concerned, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Municipal Corporations  
(Earthquake Dangers) Order (No. 2) 1970.

2. Councils authorised to exercise powers under section 301A of Act—  
The following Councils are hereby declared to be Councils to which  
section 301A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 applies, namely:

- The Mosgiel Borough Council.
- The Onehunga Borough Council.
- The Tauranga City Council.
- The Wellington City Council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

The effect of this order is that the Mosgiel Borough Council, the Onehunga  
Borough Council, the Tauranga City Council, and the Wellington City Council  
will be empowered to exercise the powers conferred by section 301A of the  
Municipal Corporations Act 1954 in relation to buildings likely to be dangerous  
in an earthquake.
