**THE MILKING-MACHINE CONTROL ORDER 1942,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939,* the Minister of Agriculture, doth hereby make the following Order.

O R D E R.

1. This Order may be cited as the Milking-machine Control Order 1942, Amendment No. 1.

2. This Order shall be read together with and form part of the Milking-machine Control Order 1942† (hereinafter called the principal Order).

3. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification hereof in the *Gazette*.

4. The principal Order is amended by revoking from clauses 4 and 5 thereof the words "other than a metal part of the same pattern and make of milking-machine as the pattern and make of milking-machine for the time being used in that dairy", and substituting therefor in each case the following words: "other than a metal part which is exclusively a renewal or replacement of a metal part of the milking-machine for the time being used in that dairy and is not an extension or duplication or stand by or spare part."
